Criteria for Scholarships

Lynn Lahey "Somos el Futuro" - \$500

1. A Latino or Latina student who has attended Corvallis Public Schools 509J for two or more years.
2. By clicking on this box I certify that I consider myself to be of Latino or Latina heritage.
3. Students active in community events or working part-time shall receive special consideration.
4. Financial Need

Clinton F. Stoddard Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000

1. Will enroll in a public Oregon community college or university.
2. Graduated from high school with a minimum of a 3.25 grade point average.
3. Students active in community events or working part-time shall receive special consideration.
4. Students shall intend to pursue a bachelor's degree in agriculture, veterinary medicine or engineering.

Susan Small Hall Scholarship - \$500

1. Graduated from high school with a minimum of a 3.25 grade point average.
2. Demonstrated strong motivation and potential for success.
3. Strong preference for a student who has participated on one of the golf teams and demonstrated good sportsmanship, leadership qualities and academic achievement.
4. Students active in community events or working part-time shall receive special consideration.

Application Process

Applicants must submit the following to the Corvallis Public Schools Foundation at 1555 SW 35th St. Corvallis, OR 97333 non later than April 30, 2008.

1. A completed *Scholarship Application Form*
2. The *Scholarship Applicant Essay*
3. Submit an unofficial copy of your most current high school transcript to the same address.
4. We require two recommendations from teachers or other school personnel who must send their recommendation directly to the Foundation office. The Recommendation Form is included in this packet. Print them out and give them to your references and ask them to complete them and send them to our office.

General Information

1. Scholarship recipients are chosen by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.
2. Foundation employees and Board of Trustees members and their dependents are ineligible.
3. Scholarship funds are sent directly to the school you attend after your school provides our office with verification of your enrollment. The verification must come directly from the college or university you attend. Often this can be arranged online through www.studentclearinghouse.org if your college or university participates in that program.
